Situation

ASU Chilliwack, the only Land Force Command Facility in the province, was in need of temporary space for classrooms as well as a change room/shower facility to support troop training. Williams Scotsman, a leading provider of mobile and modular space, was hired to provide 9,500 sq. ft. of portable space within a 2 month time frame.

Solution

Williams Scotsman supplied 7 custom built double wide buildings, for a total of 9,504 sq. ft. of additional space. The modular complex includes three classrooms, two administrative office buildings, a 1,440 sq. ft. change room/shower facility, and a storage building to be used to house supplies.

Result

Within 12 weeks of the initial order, Williams Scotsman was able to fabricate, deliver, and install ASU Chilliwack's new facilities. The buildings were all constructed with standard damage resistant corrugated steel exteriors, double glazed windows and end wall mounted BARD HVAC units. The classrooms were fitted with custom IT boxes and projection equipment to enhance the learning area. The change room/ shower facility can accommodate 40+ male and female personnel. Custom built wood decks and ramps were also provided.
