Situation

Colt, now WorleyParsons, was in need of space to be used as a unisex lavatory for an expansion project they were working on at the Consumers' Co-operative Refineries Ltd. Project in Regina, Saskatchewan. As the project progressed, Colt needed to be able to move these lavatories around the site, creating a need for units that could be easily relocated with minimal effort. Williams Scotsman, a leading provider of mobile and modular space, was hired to provide a solution.

Solution

After meeting with Colt multiple times, Williams Scotsman was able to create a custom design to fit the required specifications. Conventional lavatories require blocking, skirting, septic tank hookups and the use of trucks to move, making them labor intensive and time consuming to set up and re-locate. Williams Scotsman was able to eliminate these issues by using a ground set unit that utilized an electric forced air furnace and an on-board winterization system. Units could be relocated with the use of a fork lift and the only requirement was to disconnect and then re-connect the electric upon moving. The on-board winterization system reduced the normal winterizing time down from 2 hours to about 10 minutes. These units also meet blast zone two ratings.

Result

After the first unit was delivered, it was clear that Williams Scotsman's design was exactly what Colt needed. The design was so well received that Williams Scotsman has provided an additional 20 units to the site and has become the supplier of choice for all Colt's modular building needs.
