

# Project Profile



## North Central Crossing Pipeline Manning, AB

### Situation

TransCanada Corporation, one of the continent's largest providers in the development and operation of North American energy infrastructure, was in need of temporary workforce accommodations for personnel assigned to a pipeline construction project in Manning, AB. The workforce housing needed to accommodate 623 people as well as provide dining and recreation facilities.



### Solution

Williams Scotsman, a leading provider of mobile and modular space, was selected to supply this workforce camp. To accommodate a camp of this size, multiple dormitory configurations were utilized. The first dormitory complex housed 49 people each and featured forced air furnaces and central air conditioning, captain beds with drawers beneath, quick connects for electrical/fire alarms and a central washcar. Executive dormitory complexes were also utilized and featured double captain beds with drawers beneath, telephone/data outlets, and private and semi-private washrooms. The dining facility was a 10 unit Kitchen/Diner complex which was fully equipped with seating areas and commercial grade equipment. A recreation area was also supplied. The entire camp totaled 128 units.

### Result

Williams Scotsman supplied a fully functional workforce camp to house 623 people working the North Central Crossing Pipeline.
